Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.579 dated 6.9.2019 registered under Sections 21, 61, 85 of NDPS Act at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that recovery of 50 grams of Heroin is from Deepak @ Deepu and the petitioner has been falsely implicated on the disclosure statement of aforesaid co-accused. He further submits that Deepak @ Deepu has been granted concession of regular bail.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Atma Ram has stated that the petitioner is involved in another criminal case under NDPS Act. He further submits that as per disclosure statement Deepak @ Deepu has purchased Heroin from the petitioner. He further informs the Court that investigating agency has collected call details which show that Deepak @ Deepu was

in regular touch of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to grant concession of pre-arrest bail is made out.

Dismissed.
