On 27.09.2019, following order was passed:-

*“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.185, dated 22.09.2016, registered under Sections 419/420/465/467/468/471/120-B IPC, at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is only a marginal witness of the registered sale deed as he was known to the purchaser. He further submits that the petitioner has no role to play in the aforesaid alleged criminal offence.*

*Notice of motion for 27.11.2019.*

*On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the petition be handed over to Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, during the course of the day.*

*In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”*

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder

Singh, has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the

investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 27.09.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
