Learned counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated 02.09.2019 (Annexure P-18) served by few of the petitioners, within some specified time in terms of the judgment dated 27.05.2015 passed in Civil Writ Petition No.7626 of 2015 titled as Gurmail Kaur & others Versus State of Haryana & others (Annexure P-11) and as well as the order dated 19.08.2019 passed in LPA No.1215 of 2015 withdrawing the appeal (Annexure P-15).

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 02.09.2019 (Annexure P-18) by treating the same on behalf of all the petitioners, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioners is to be accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to them, in accordance with law and if the claim of the petitioner is not to be accepted, then a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.

It is made clear that in case the legal notice is not decided within two months, there shall be costs of ₹ 25,000/- to be paid to all the petitioners.
