The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.34 dated 18.02.2019, under Sections 379B/34/411 IPC, registered at Police Station City Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner had snatched the purse of the complainant. The petitioner is in custody over 08 months. He also contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case as he was involved in another Case bearing FIR No.137 dated 25.08.2018, wherein it was alleged that the petitioner had snatched a bag from the girl but the girl did not appear in the course of the investigation and petitioner had been granted regular bail in that case. He also contends that the petitioner is 25 years of age and is in custody

over 08 months

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh, states that 2 out of 14 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 08 months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
