Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.174 dated 07.07.2018 registered under Sections 341/365/323 IPC and Sections 342/34/302/326 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act (added later on) at Police Station Sarangpur, Chandigarh.

Counsel for the petitioner relies upon orders passed by this Court Annexure P-4 dated 26.08.2019, Annexure P-5 dated 09.09.2019, Annexure P-6 dated 18.09.2019, Annexure P-7 dated 24.09.2019 which pertain to the co-accused.

Learned counsel for the Union Territory, has informed the Court that although petitioner is recorded to be armed with country made weapon, however, same was never been used. As per post mortem report, cause of death is diabetes. Petitioner is in custody since 12.07.2018.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
