Today, other than the fact that learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Kulbir Singh, submits that the petitioner having joined investigation, her custodial interrogation is not required, learned counsel for the petitioner has also produced in Court an affidavit of Jagprit Singh, son of the petitioner, who is shown to be living in California, stating to the effect that he had authorised his mother to 'do all acts qua his land/his share in the land', while he was away from India.

It is to be noticed that the allegation against the petitioner and her other son is that such son impersonated Jagprit Singh to get a sale deed executed in favour of the petitioner, though the sale deed was eventually not executed, the Registrar having refused to do so and having in fact lodged a complaint as regards impersonation.

Keeping in view all the aforesaid circumstances, but without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the order dated

27.9.2019 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

The petition is disposed of.
