Petitioner-Sunehari Devi has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to the official respondents for registration of FIR under relevant sections regarding theft of wheat and paddy crops from the land of the petitioner against respondent Nos.6 to 12.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite repeated complaints given by the petitioner, no action has been taken. He submits that the land in question belongs to the petitioner and the accused persons are repeatedly extending threats to harvest her crop.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the representation dated 30.10.2018, this Court does not find any reason to invoke inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C as the averments do not reveal commission of any cognizable offence. It may be added here that in

the event of threat to disturb the possession of the petitioner, the effective remedy would be to seek injunction from the Civil Court.

Petition is dismissed.
