**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.237 dated 28.09.2018, under Sections 304/34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Bound Kalan, District Charkhi Dadri.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in the FIR, the petitioners had been attributed injuries on stomach and foot but MLR of the injured did not indicate any injury on the stomach and foot. The injured had expired after two months. The complainant, who had appeared as PW-1 did not support the prosecution case and had stated that the deceased had sustained the injuries after falling from the roof. The petitioner No.1 is in custody for over 9 months while petitioner No.2 is in custody for over 1 year and 2 months. He also contends that PW-2 namely Ramvati, who is the mother of the deceased, PW-3 namely Devender who is another eye witness and PW-4 namely Vikash, who is cousin of the deceased, have also not supported the prosecution

case qua the involvement of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Pardeep Kumar, states that 10 out of 23 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners, especially when petitioners No.1 and 2 are in custody for over 9 months and 1 year, 2 months respectively and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
