The present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for directing the respondents to release the petitioner for two weeks on emergency parole to enable him to attend and organize the marriage function of his niece.

Short reply has been filed by the Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar, whereby it has been averred that marriage of niece of the petitioner is to take place on 14.10.2019, as per the report of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural dated 30.09.2019 (Annexure R-1).

On 30.09.2019, it was directed that the case of the petitioner for emergency parole for attending the marriage of his niece may be processed on urgent basis. But the same has not been done.

Accordingly, the competent authority shall process the case of the petitioner and pass necessary orders on his request for parole within a period of one week from today.

A copy of this order be given to the counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of the Special Secretary of this Court.

The writ petition is disposed of, accordingly.
