Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.266 dated 21.03.2017 registered under Sections 25, 54 and 59 of Arms Act, 1959 (Sections 54 and 59 of Arms Act are deleted later on) at Police Station Gurgaon City, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that due to some confusion about the date of hearing the petitioner could not appear during trial before learned trial Court on 21.12.2018 as a result of which non-bailable warrants were issued against him. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to appear and join the proceedings before the trial Court.

The explanation offered appears to be reasonable.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Arun Beniwal, DAG, Haryana , who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is disposed off. The petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on or

before 03.10.2019, who shall then be admitted to bail on his furnishing fresh bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.
