By way of instant petition, the petitioner has sought quashing of order dated 06.09.2019 (Annexure P-7), vide which the transfer order dated 10.07.2019 (Annexure P-1) transferring the petitioner from the office of respondent No.3-Labour Inspector, Derabassi to the office of Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal, Mohali, has been wrongly implemented by misinterpreting interim order dated 22.08.2009 (Annexure P-5) passed by this Court in CWP No. 22384 of 2019 and by ignoring the Transfer Policy Annexure P-9 and P-10.

2. Contents of the writ petition have been perused.
3. Transfer being matter of administrative exigencies, this Court generally interferes, if at all, very cautiously. Transfer is not a punishment but an essential aspect of service,

particularly, on a transferable post.

4. In my opinion, in the present case, the impugned order dated 06.09.2019 (Annexure P-7) in the transfer order dated 10.07.2019 (Annexure P-1) does not call for any interference from this Court in exercise of its extraordinary writ jurisdiction vested under Article 226 of Constitution of India.

5. Petition is, accordingly, dismissed being devoid of any merit.
