On 27.9.2019 following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest
bail in FIR No. 151, dated 9.8.2019, registered under
Sections 34/323/379-B of the Indian Penal Code, at
Police Station Division-B, Police Commissionerate,
Amritsar.

Notice of motion for 27.11.2019.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender
Beniwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of
the State. A copy of the petition be handed over to
Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, during the
course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest,
the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject
to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the

satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.
However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as
and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the
conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

On the next date of hearing, learned State counsel on
instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh has submitted that although
petitioner has joined the investigation. He is not cooperating by not
disclosing the names of two other co-accused.

Today once again the position is same This Court has also
examined the alleged CCTV footage of the incident.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, this Court is
not inclined to grant concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
