This application was filed for disposing of the appeal in view of a compromise arrived at between the parties on 08.01.2019. The present appeal has arisen from the judgement and decree by which a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') filed by the appellant-husband was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that the parties have arrived at a compromise which has been reduced into writing on 08.01.2019 as per which both the parties have decided to part ways on payment of lump sum amount of ₹1.28 crores towards the full and final settlement.
