AMIT RAWAL, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner is seeking indulgence of this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the inaction of the respondents in not regularizing the services of petitioner as per instructions dated 22.06.1998 (Annexure P-4) and not giving the benefit of continuity of service with all consequential benefits. In this regard, had submitted notice dated 26.11.2018 (Annexure P-6), but there is no adherence thereto.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3-Director General, State Transport Department, Haryana, to consider the notice dated 26.11.2018 (Annexure P-6), within a stipulated period.

Without going into the merits and demerits of the claim of the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.3, to consider the notice dated 26.11.2018 (Annexure P-6), within a period of one month from

the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and shall pass a speaking order thereon after affording opportunity of hearing to petitioner, failing which, respondent No.3 shall be liable to pay costs of ₹25,000/- to petitioner.

This condition of imposing costs is only to prevent petitioner to run from pillar to post and avail remedy of contempt in case of non-compliance of directions issued by this Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction.
