This appeal has arisen from the judgment and decree dated 23.1.2018 by which a petition filed by the appellant husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') for seeking dissolution of marriage with the respondent on the ground of cruelty and desertion was dismissed.

During pendency of this appeal, parties have entered into a settlement/agreement which was reduced into writing on 13.9.2018. As per the said settlement/agreement they had filed a petition under Section 13-B of the Act before the Court at Kaithal. Counsel for the appellant has informed the Court that the said petition under Section 13-B of the Act has already been filed in Court and statement at first motion stage had been recorded.

In view thereof, counsel for the appellant has made a prayer for withdrawal of this appeal, at this stage with liberty to file an application for recalling of this order, in case the respondent resiles from the settlement.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
