This appeal has arisen from the judgment and decree of the trial Court by which appeal filed by the appellant under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 [for short 'the Act'] for seeking restitution of conjugal rights was dismissed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent has informed the Court that the parties had entered into a compromise on 30.11.2018 before the Mediator of this Court and in view thereof, both the parties filed a petition under Section 13B of the Act for seeking decree of divorce by way of mutual consent before the Court at Jalandhar. It is also submitted that the statements at the first motion stage have already been recorded and the statements at second motion stage are mto be recorded on 25.7.2019.

In view of the aforesaid, there is no necessity of keeping this case alive, therefore, the present appeal is hereby dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the appellant to file an application for its revival in case the respondent-wife resile from her statement at the second motion stage.
