In view of the grounds taken in the application, delay of 280 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

The application stands disposed of.

Appeal

Challenge has been laid to the judgment of learned Single Judge rendered in CWP No. 8549 of 2009 on 17.11.2016.

The respondent lost his father in 1991. He attained the majority in 2008. The appellant State has framed the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of the Deceased Government Employees' Rules, 2006, whereby the monetary benefits have to be given to the legal heirs of the deceased employee at different stages. The case of the respondent was to be considered at the time when the family became eligible for consideration under the Rules and not at the time of death of their bread earner.

Accordingly, there is no merit in the appeal. The same is dismissed.
