The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the official respondents No.2 to 4 to investigate the matter fairly and impartially in FIR No.85 dated 04.04.2019 under Sections 376-D, 120-B and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh, Mewat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is husband of the alleged victim. There are some matrimonial differences between the petitioner and his wife and it is for this reason, the aforesaid FIR has been registered against the petitioner. However, he confines his prayer for a fair investigation in the case for which the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 05.08.2019 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Nuh.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, A.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Lest it may prejudice the interest of the parties, without observing anything on the merits of the case and considering the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Nuh to have fair and impartial investigation in the case.
