Impugned herein is the order dated 12.09.2019 (Annexure P-3) whereby petitioner has been transferred from 5th Punjab Battalion, Patiala to 6th Girls Battalion, Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

2. Contents of the writ petition have been perused.
3. Transfer being matter of administrative exigencies, this Court generally interferes, if at all, very cautiously. Transfer is not a punishment but an essential aspect of service, particularly, on a transferable post.
4. In my opinion, in the present case, the impugned order dated 12.09.2019 (Annexure P-3) does not call for any interference by this Court in exercise of its extraordinary writ jurisdiction vested under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

Petition is, accordingly, dismissed being devoid of any merit.
