Petitioner-Raghubir Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.346 dated 09.09.2019 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Civil Line Jind, District Jind.

The FIR was lodged on the communication sent by Deputy Superintendent Jail Jind to SHO Police Station Civil Line, Jind, wherein it was alleged that convict-Vikas @ Billu son of Raghubir, in order to obtain parole had produced false medical certificate regarding the ailment of his father, Raghubir Singh (petitioner). As per the prosecution, the father of convict got treatment from Acharya Tulsi Regional Cancer Treatment and Research Centre Bikaner, as per the discharge follow up card dated 14.07.2019 and on the basis of the biopsy No. CYC-986-19 dated 05.06.2019 of Niravana Diagnostic Centre, PGIMS Road, Rohtak Centre. Since the convict was a hardcore criminal, therefore, after inquiry it was

found that the said biopsy belonged to one Wazir son of Pirthi and not Raghbir son of Pyare Lal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that at least it is not disputed that the father of the petitioner was once treated at Bikaner. During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the authorities have telephonic conversations between petitioner and his son regarding procuring medical certificate to facilitate parole. Learned counsel is unable to explain the conduct of petitioner as to why the petitioner indulged in alleged act, if he was actually suffering from the ailment.

Therefore, without commenting on the merits of this case, this Court does not find any ground for grant of extra ordinary concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is dismissed.
