The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.139 dated 22.08.2019 registered under Sections 323, 326, 506, 34 at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran.

The operative part of the order dated 30.09.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that vide order dated 13.09.2019, the petitioners were granted interim anticipatory bail. It is further submitted that thereafter, the same has been dismissed as the petitioners did not join the investigation on time. Counsel for the petitioner(s) undertake that the petitioners will appear before the Investigating Officer on 04.10.2019 at 10:00 sharp or any other date or time fixed by him, to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 23.10.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 30.09.2019, has already appeared before the

SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Inderjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 30.09.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
