The writ petition was disposed of with the following
directions:-

“In view of these facts and circumstances, award dated 22.04.2015(Annexure P-3) passed by the Labour Court is set aside. Zila Parishad-respondent No.4 and respondents No.2 & 3 are hereby directed to accommodate petitioner as a para medico worker. If the vacancies are not available at Shri Mukatsar Sahib District, in that event, respondent No.2 is hereby directed to create a supernumerary post of para medico and adjust the petitioner by reinstating him. Such exercise shall be completed within a period of three months from today. It is made clear that the petitioner is not entitled to back wages. Petitioner is entitled to continuity of services.”

Zila Parishad is in appeal against order passed in CWP

No.20942 of 2015, and State itself has accommodated the respondent No.5 by giving him employment.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the instant appeal and the same is hereby stands disposed of.
