By way of instant petition, the petitioner has sought quashing of order dated 08.08.2019 (Annexure P-3) whereby head quarter of the petitioner has been fixed at District Consumer Forum, Sangrur. In the circumstances, the petitioner also caused representation dated 28.08.2019 (Annexure P-5), but the same has not been adverted to till date by the respondents. Hence this petition.

2. Notice of motion.
3. On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Samina Dhir, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.
4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further

proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 28.08.2019 (Annexure P-5) sympathetically keeping in view the fact that daughter of the petitioner is suffering from eye blindness as her visibility is 25% only and he has also to look after his ailing mother who is 82 years. The respondents shall also keep in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. Disposed of in above terms.
