Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.22 dated 21.03.2019, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 326, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Qadian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 30.09.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that occurrence had taken place on 21.03.2019, whereas Section 326 has been added on 09.04.2019.

Notice of motion for 31.10.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under

Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

 Contends that in terms of above order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

 Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep, has acknowledged that in terms of order dated 30.09.2019, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

 In view of above, interim order dated 30.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

 It is also made clear that petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

 Disposed off accordingly.
