The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.116 dated 29.08.2019, under Sections 323, 325, 148, 149 IPC (later on added Sections 379 and 427 IPC), registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is 17 years of age and although he is alleged to have given blow with an iron rod on the face of the complainant but the injury was found to be simple in nature. He further contends that the FIR was registered after 07 days of the occurrence. He also contends that although the complainant is alleged to have gone to the Civil Hospital, Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur for treatment and he was referred to Civil Hospital, Hoshiarpur for further treatment but he had gone to private hospital at Nawashahar. The medico legal report is also obtained from the private hospital which casts doubt on the version of the complainant.

This Court, by the order dated 01.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but recovery of ₹6,000/- and equipments which the petitioner has allegedly stolen from the shop of the complainant is to be effected from him.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 01.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.

Criminal Misc. No.36569 of 2019 also stands disposed of.
