By way of instant petition, the petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to implement the judgment dated 20.05.2013 (Annexure P-6) rendered by this court in CWP No. 16446 of 2010, as for the similarly placed employees and have prayed for grant of benefit of Assured Career Progression Scheme to the petitioners as per Policy dated 03.11.2006 (Annexure P-3) along with all consequential benefits i.e re-fixation of pay, arrears etc. The petitioners also caused issuance of a Legal Notice dated 22.05.2019 (Annexure P-7) but the same has not been adverted to till date. Hence the writ petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms.Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 22.05.2019 (Annexure P-7) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

7. Disposed of in above terms.
