[1] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has submitted representation, Annexure P-4 dated 24.08.2017, besides, served legal notice, Annexure P-5 dated 20.04.2019 in respect of the grievances which are the subject matter of the instant writ petition but that no action has been taken in respect thereto till date and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice, Annexure P-5 dated 20.04.2019 in a time bound manner.
