Pursuant to the order dated 08.11.2019, an affidavit of Ms. Parvinder Kaur, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Airport, Amritsar City, has been filed in court today by learned State counsel, a copy of which has been given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

However, learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Waris Masih who is present in court to assist him, submits that in any case the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation presently is not required.

In view of the aforesaid statement, the petition is disposed of, with the order dated 01.10.2019 made absolute, on the same terms and conditions.

However, the aforesaid order will not be treated to be an observation of this court on the merits of the case, but only in view of the fact that the investigating agency itself has stated that it does not require custodial interrogation

of the petitioner.
