Prayer in the present writ petition is for directing the respondents to grant the benefit of one increment which becomes due on 1st July of the retirement of the years of the petitioners with all consequential benefits and also to revise their pay.

Learned counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated 12.07.2019 (Annexure P-2) served by them, within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 12.07.2019 (Annexure P-2) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioners is to be accepted, the

consequential benefits, if any, be released to them, in accordance with law and if the claim of the petitioner is not to be accepted, then a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.

It is made clear that in case the legal notice is not decided within two months, there shall be costs of ₹ 25,000/- to be paid to the petitioners.
