Petitioners are stated to be in a live in relationship. Petitioner no.1 is stated to be 17 years old whereas petitioner no.2 is 25 years old.

Petitioners seek a Mandamus for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents no.4 to 7, who happen to be the immediate/close relative of petitioner no.1.

Without even commenting on the liaison between the petitioners and confining the scope of the instant petition only as regards protection of life and liberty, instant petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent no.3 as regards their threat perception. In the eventuality of any such application being filed, respondent no.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
