On 24.07.2018 this Court had passed the following order :

“We are informed that the Complaints Committee is actively considering the complaint and is likely to form its view-point within a short span. We thus do not deem it appropriate at this juncture to call upon the respondents and decide the appeal on merits, particularly when the Complaints Committee has been re-constituted in accordance with law. The Complaints Committee will continue with the matter regardless of the fact that this appeal is kept pending. The Complaints Committee shall decide the matter uninfluenced of the *prima-facie* observations, if any, made in the order dated 12.07.2018 passed by the learned Single Judge.

Let a copy of this order be given *dasti* to learned counsel for the appellant.”

It is now candidly conceded before us that the report of the Committee is adverse to the appellant. The appellant, therefore, prays for permission to withdraw the present appeal with liberty to question the findings of the Committee and take up all the pleas including the ones taken

before the writ court. Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid granted.
