Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 177 dated 05.11.2018 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that when the FSL report was not received, the petitioner was granted interim bail on 11.02.2019, subject to furnishing personal bonds and two sureties of ₹2.00 lakh each, till the receipt of the FSL report. When the report was tendered in the Court, the petitioner surrendered before the Court.

It has been brought to the notice of this Court that out of 15 witnesses, only 2 witnesses have been examined. The trial would take time to conclude.

Without commenting anything on the merits lest it should prejudice the case either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
