Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 68 dated 2.8.2019 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act at Police Station City Banga, District SBS Nagar.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner alongwith co-accused Saudagar Singh were found in possession of 15 injections of Buprenorphine and 15 injections of Avil, each from both the co-accused. It is undisputed that the injection Avil does not fall under the notification issued under NDPS Act. Thus, the total recovery from the petitioner is 15 injections of Buprenorphine.

Petitioner is in custody since 2.8.2019. Investigations are complete. Trial of the case is yet to start. Conclusion of the trial is likely to take time. As per the information supplied by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rashpal Singh, petitioner is not involved in any other

case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.
