ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.224 dated 1.9.2019 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station City, Moga.

Allegations are that petitioner charged Rs.30,000/- per child for ensuring their immigration to foreign country. As per the advertisement, petitioner had declared that he would himself arrange for Guaranteed Income Certificate (GIC).

The Deputy Commissioner has carried out investigation and found that visa of around 200 students has been rejected and 26 students have received communication that they stand barred for next 5 years on account of fake Guaranteed Income Certificate (GIC).

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that his client had filed civil suits against the first informant and certain other students.

Mere filing of the suit does not prove that petitioner is innocent.

In view thereof, there is no ground to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioner. Hence, dismissed.
