On 01.11.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner points that the petitioner was working as Dispatch Incharge with the first informant/company and his duty was only to ensure proper dispatch of the goods. He further submits that petitioner has no role to play in preparation of fake Methadi tax receipts or forging of invoices or in clearance of the payments.

Learned counsel for the State prays for time to file a detailed reply.

Learned counsel for the first informant also prays for time to file reply.

Adjourned to 18.11.2019.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released

on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Thereafter, petitioner had joined investigation. However, his presence was required by the Investigating Officer for further questioning. Hence, petitioner was once again directed to join investigation on 22.11.2019.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Inspector Arvind, has submitted that the petitioner has once again joined the investigation. However, he submits that the petitioner is required to give his specimen handwriting and signatures for which the prosecution intend to move an application before the trial Court.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, interim protection granted on 01.11.2019 is made absolute subject to petitioner appearing before the trial Court as and when called upon to give his specimen handwriting and signatures.

Disposed of, accordingly.
