Petitioner is seeking indulgence of this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing impugned transfer order dated 22.08.2019 (Annexure P-2) or directing the official respondents for cancellation of the same and also prayer for stay of operation of impugned transfer order dated 22.08.2019 (Annexure P-2), impugned letter/order dated 08.08.2019 (Annexure P-13) and Clause 8(i)(a) of the Transfer Policy dated 05.06.2017 (Annexure P-3) as well as relieving order of petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner intends to make a representation and he will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Director Secondary Education, Sector 5, Panchkula, to consider the representation within a stipulated period.

Without going into the merits and demerits of the claim of the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2, to consider the

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representation, which the petitioner intends to submit and decide the same within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order after affording opportunity of hearing to petitioner, failing which, respondent No.2, shall be liable to pay costs of ₹25,000/- to petitioner.

This condition of imposing costs is only to prevent petitioner to run from pillar to post and avail remedy of contempt in case of non-compliance of directions issued by this Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction.
