Counsel has been heard at length and the pleadings on record have been perused.

It has been averred that the petitioners had sold a certain parcel of land to respondent No.3 vide two registered sale deeds dated 21.12.2012 for a total sale consideration of Rs.57 lakhs approximately.

Apparently, certain litigations arose pertaining to the same very piece of land as suit was instituted by Baljit Kaur and others claiming themselves to be the successors of Jaswant Singh and Karam Singh to whom the land had been mortgaged and in the sale deed dated 21.12.2012 between the petitioners and respondent No.3 the same was specifically recorded .

The precise grievance raised in the instant petition is that respondent No.2 i.e. SHO, Police Station Khanna, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana and who has been impleaded by name is repeatedly harassing the petitioners at the instance of respondent No.3 to compromise the matter and to return a lump sum amount of Rs.1.5 crores against the sale consideration amount of Rs.57 lakhs approximately.

In paragraphs 9 and 10 of the writ petition, it has been categorically averred that the petitioners have been summoned by respondent No.2 to the police station and have been made to sit on the floor for the entire day on many occasions including 01.08.2019.

In view of the grievance raised in the petition and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments contained therein, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna to look into the matter against the backdrop of an application dated 16.09.2019 (Annexure P-10) which is stated to have already been made and thereafter to take steps as he may deem fit and necessary in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
