The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in FIR No.455 dated 01.09.2019 under Sections 323, 354-A and 506 read with Section 34 IPC (Section 379-A added later on) registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt., District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during pendency of the present petition, the matter has been compromised between the parties. He has produced the copy of Panchayati compromise dated 27.11.2019 so entered between the petitioner and his wife Mehak Malhotra, which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Neha, does not dispute the factum of compromise.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the complainant, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 03.10.2019, whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days notice shall be served upon him.
