The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 113, dated 30.12.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 326 IPC and Section 3(4) SC/ST Act, registered at Police Station Cantt. Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no allegation whatsoever in the said FIR for invoking Section 3(4) SC/ST Act. The co-accused namely Karandeep Singh has been granted anticipatory bail by Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-9493-2018 on 14.02.2019. The petitioner was found innocent during investigation and has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

This Court, by the order dated 01.10.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and he was to be released on ad-interim bail to its satisfaction.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 11.10.2019 in terms of the previous order of this Court.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having appeared before the trial Court, the order dated 01.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
