The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 58 dated 11.06.2019, under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 and 307 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is alleged to have hit the complainant with a brick bat. There is delay of 6 days in registering the FIR. The offence under Section 307 IPC was added later on after obtaining the medical opinion from a private hospital. He further contends that the petitioner is 26 years of age and is not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 15.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Tejinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 15.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
