Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.133 dated 28.08.2019 under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Bathinda.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 03.10.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the FIR, though it is stated that the complainant has given some amount to the petitioner, but no date/month/year has been mentioned...”

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Jaspal Singh and

assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 03.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
