Petitioners seek a mandamus for directing the official respondents to take necessary steps for protection of their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.6 to 8.

As per pleadings on record, petitioner No.1 is aged 30 years and petitioner No.2 is 34 years. Both the petitioners are stated to be in a live in relationship.

Petitioner No.1 is otherwise married to one Parshotam and out of wedlock there are two children and who are minors. Petitioner No.2 is also married with one Karnalo and out of wedlock there are three children.

Both the petitioners have chosen to stay away from their married partners and even have left their children to be fended by their respective husband/wife.

Under no circumstances, this Court can approve of the relationship/liaison, between the petitioners.

That apart pleadings on record are wholly insufficient for this Court to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

No intervention in the matter is called for.

Petition dismissed.
