The petitioner is seeking interim bail to enable him to attend his ailing mother.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that during the pendency of this petition, the mother of the petitioner has expired on 06.10.2019 and the kirya ceremony is slated on 17.10.2019 and therefore, he be permitted to be released on interim bail for a period of three days to enable him to attend the ceremony.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2-CBI states that the petitioner is an accused in a double murder case, he is also involved in several other cases and therefore, the petitioner can be permitted to attend the kirya ceremony of his mother only under police custody for one day i.e. 17.10.2019. He also states that the petitioner was permitted by the Judicial Magistrate by order dated 06.10.2019 to attend the cremation of his mother under police escort.

Heard.

The petitioner is under trial in a double murder case and the kirya ceremony of his mother is slated on 17.10.2019. It would be in the interest of justice if the petitioner is permitted to attend the kirya ceremony of his mother under police escort.

Therefore, the petitioner shall be taken from the Central Jail, Hisar on 17.10.2019 at 08.00 am to his native village-Chautala under police escort and after attending the kirya ceremony, he shall be brought back to Central Jail, Hisar by 06.00 pm.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
