Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for seeking quashing of FIR No. 197 dated 28.09.2018, registered under Section(s) 323, 341, 451 & 506 IPC at Police Station Mataur, District S.A.S. Nagar on the basis of compromise dated 21.09.2019 (Annexure P2).

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 appeared.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Vide order dated 04.10.2019, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Area Magistrate on 30.10.2019 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise.

A report dated 04.11.2019 of learned JMIC, SAS Nagar (Mohali), has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned JMIC SAS Nagar (Mohali) and got recorded their statements

considered view that the compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Keeping in view the above facts, I am of the considered opinion that it is a fit case in which the impugned FIR is liable to be quashed.

Therefore, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 197 dated 28.09.2018, registered under Section(s) 323, 341, 451 & 506 IPC at Police Station Mataur, District S.A.S. Nagar, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner are hereby quashed.
