The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 128 dated 12.08.2019 registered under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (**NDPS**) Act, 1985, at Police Station Maloya, District Chandigarh.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though there is recovery of 11 injections without label but the FSL report has not yet been received.

On the instructions from SI Punjab Rai, learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that FSL report is still awaited.

Without commenting anything on the merits lest, it should prejudice the case either side, the petitioner is granted interim bail, subject to

furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned, till the receipt of FSL report. On receipt of FSL report, the petitioner would surrender before the learned trial Court.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
