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KRISHNA MURARI, C.J. (ORAL)

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents No. 2 to 4 makes a statement to make payment of the enhanced compensation of ₹ 3 lacs awarded by the learned Single Judge to the appellant-workman. He further states that the amount of ₹ 25,000/- awarded by the Labour Court has already been paid to the appellant-workman. A demand draft of the balance amount of ₹ 2,75,000/- was sent to the appellant-workman, but he refused to accept the same. He further states that after getting the demand draft revalidated, the same shall be paid to the appellant-workman within a period of three weeks from today.

The offer has been accepted by learned counsel for the appellant without any reservation.

In view of the settlement arrived at between the parties before us, the appeal stands disposed of in terms of the same.

In case, respondents No. 2 to 4 fail to carry out the commitment, it shall be open to the appellant-workman to make an application for revival of the appeal.
