On 03.10.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

*“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR
No.108, dated 07.09.2019, registered under Sections 306/34
IPC at Police Station City-II, Malerkotla, District Sangrur.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even
from the reading of FIR, offence under Section 107 IPC read
with Section 306 IPC is not made out.*

Notice of motion for 22.11.2019.

*On asking of the Court, Mr. SPS Tinna, Addl.
A.G.,Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of
the petition be handed over to Mr. SPS Tinna, Addl.
A.G.,Punjab, during the course of the day.*

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner

shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Daljit Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 03.10.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
