Prayer is for grant of bail pending trial in FIR No. 147 dated 3.9.2018 registered under Sections 148, 149, 302 IPC and Sections 25, 54 of Arms Act at Police Station Bicchor, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from SI Shyam Singh has submitted that prosecution has already examined 13 witnesses out of total 18 and the next date fixed is 14.11.2019 for recording prosecution evidence.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that prosecution has examined four eye witnesses and they have not supported the case of the prosecution and hence further incarceration of the petitioner would not be justified.

Keeping in view the facts of the present case, this petition is disposed of with direction to the prosecuting agency to examine their remaining witnesses on the next date of hearing i.e 14.11.2019 positively as

all are official witnesses. Learned Sessions Judge is requested to record the

statement of all prosecution witnesses and make a sincere endeavour to conclude the trial within two months.
