Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.217 dated 23.08.2019 under Sections 21/22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 03.10.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and was nominated on the disclosure statement of co-accused Rahul Kumar, from whom the recovery already stands effected...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required

for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 03.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
