Petitioner is seeking indulgence of this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the transfer order dated 06.09.2019 and further writ for quashing Clause No.7 (i)(c) of Policy dated 29.06.2016 (Annexure P-1) and Clause 8 (i)(a) of amended policy dated 05.06.2017 (Annexure P-2). In this regard, had submitted representation dated 25.09.2019 (Annexure P-11), but there is no adherence thereto.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 25.09.2019 (Annexure P-11) within a stipulated period.

Without going into the merits and demerits of the claim of the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2, to consider the representation dated 25.09.2019 (Annexure P-11) and decide the same within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of

this order, by passing a speaking order after affording opportunity of hearing to petitioner, failing which, respondent No.2, shall be liable to pay costs of ₹25,000/- to petitioner.

This condition of imposing costs is only to prevent petitioner to run from pillar to post and avail remedy of contempt in case of non-compliance of directions issued by this Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction.
